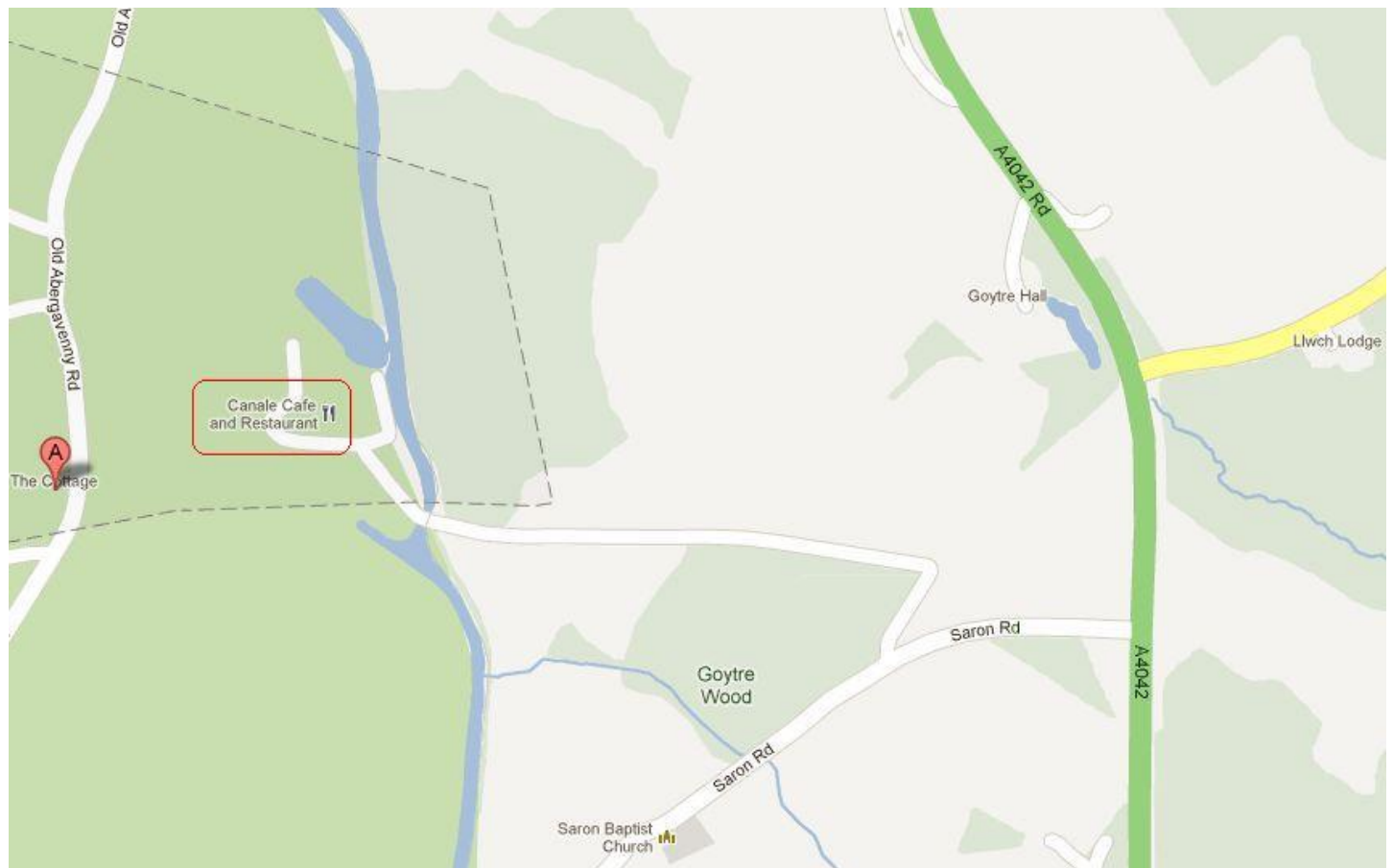

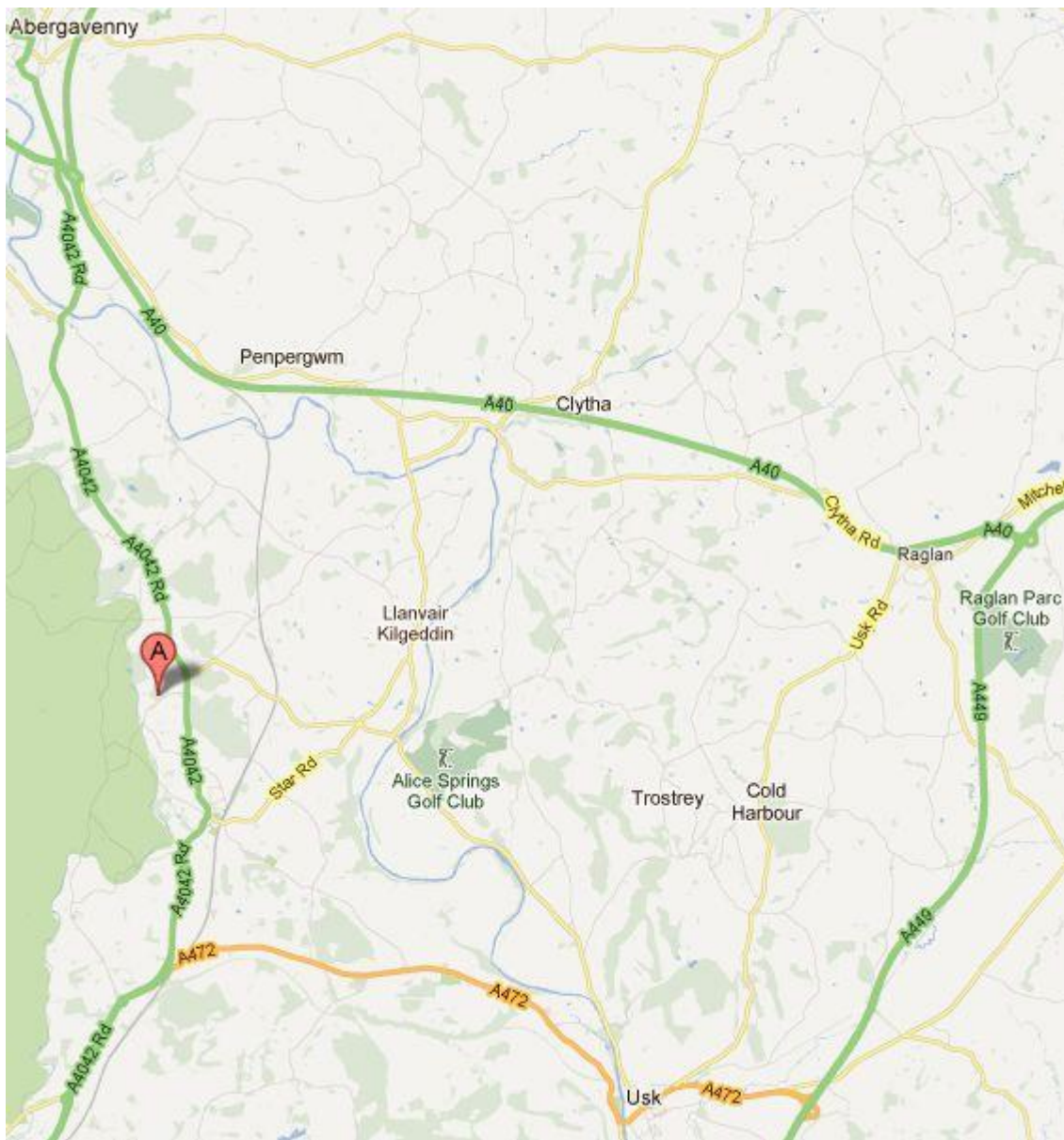
Terry has suggested meeting up at Aust Services on the M48 at 11am.

Our own Kevin Howard is organising this year's Jensen-Healey day.

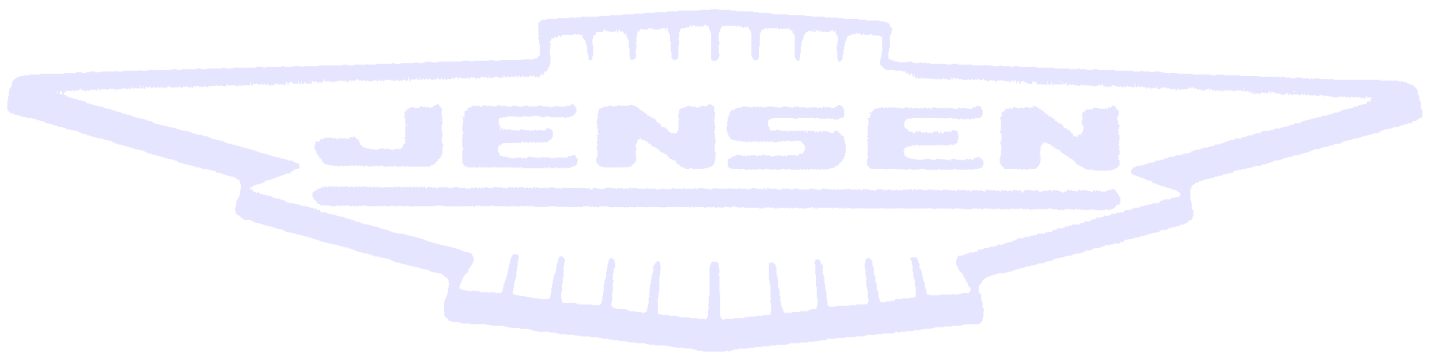
